
DairyHauler is a phone app that can be downloaded from both the Google/Apple stores.

This is a good indication that this is the third load of the day.</p>



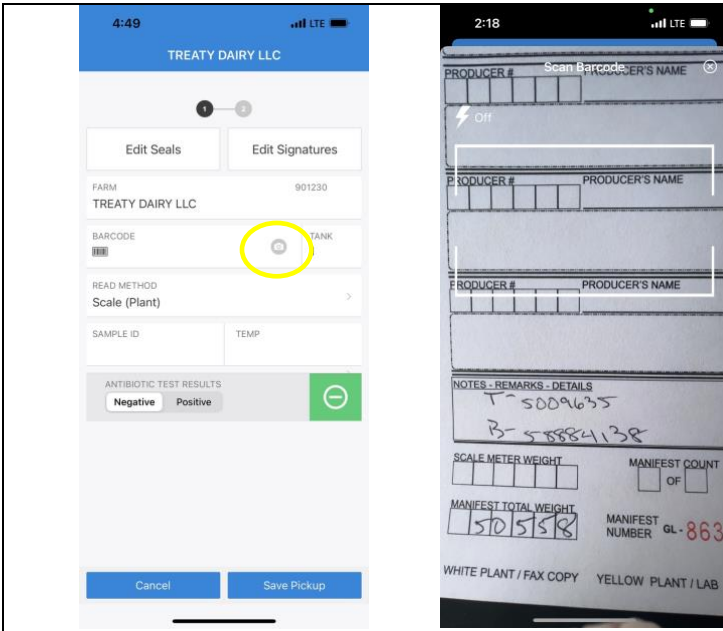

This is where you begin entering farm pickup(s).

Click on the merge arrows (circled in yellow) to bring up a list of farms.

Scroll thru the list of farms to find the farm you’re currently picking up. Then click on that farm.

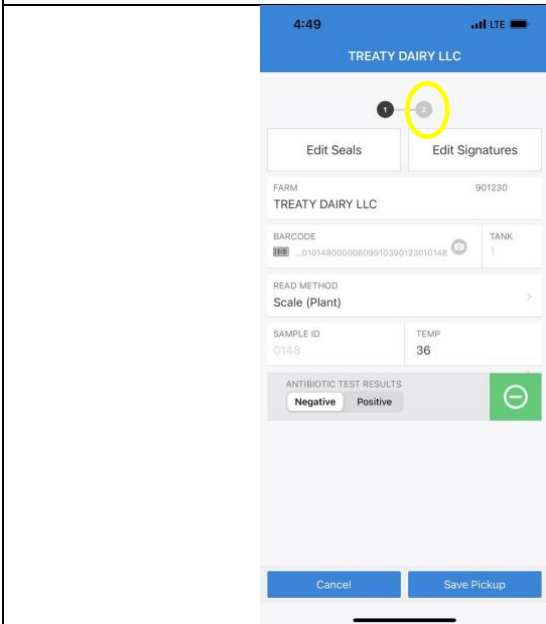


In this example, the “TREATY DAIRY LLC” has been chosen from the list above of farms.

On this page, you will click on the camera symbol (circled in yellow). This will bring your phone camera up (you may need to give DairyHauler permission to access your camera) and you aim the camera at the sticker on the manifest. The right picture shows what the camera view looks like. You aim the box at the sticker.

This should load the barcode from the sticker to the “BARCODE” field and the “SAMPLE ID” field.



Then click on the “TEMP” field and enter the appropriate temperature of the milk.




This is what the page will look like after scanning the bar code and entering the temperature.

Now click on the “2” that is circled in yellow.


	<p>On this page you enter the “EST. TOTAL” which is the wait on the manifest.</p> <p>Once the weight is entered, click on the “Edit Seals”, to enter the seal numbers on the tanker.</p>
	<p>Normally you enter the “Rear” and “Top” seal numbers.</p> <p>These will be documented on the washtag for the tanker.</p> <p>Right picture shows a completed page, with the seal numbers.</p> <p>Once the seal numbers are entered, click on the back arrow on the upper left part of the page.</p>

You will be returned to this page after clicking the back arrow on the “Manage Seals” page.

Verify the weight and then click “Save Pickup”.



Some farms (in this example it does) will prompt you to enter the manifest number.

Simply enter the manifest number and click “Ok”.




You will also get a message as displayed in right picture. Simply click “Ok”.

Currently this app is used for:

1140 – Yankee Springs. You will need to do the above steps twice for that farm, as there are 2 tanks being load.

1230 – Treaty Dairy. This farm is a direct load, so only 1 entry is required.

		<p>Once you've entered all the farms for this route (again, it may be just one). Click the "Finish Route" button on the bottom of the page.</p> <p>The left picture is where you will click "Finish Route".</p> <p>Once you click "Finish Route", a list of plants will appear. Select the Plant you are delivering this load to.</p> <p>Since this is predominantly used for Walmart, you general select "BKF US01-FORT WAYNE". This is the Walmart manufacturing plant in Fort Wayne.</p>
	<p>You can adjust the time by clicking "Edit" or simply ignore it. You will see a security code (circled). You will need this to gain entry to the Walmart plant, along with the route number.</p>	
	<p>Once at the plant, you will need to complete the route.</p> <p>You select "Negative" for the antibiotic test.</p> <p>Scan the barcode provided by the receivers.</p> <p>Enter the washtag information.</p> <p>Have the receiver sign the screen.</p> <p>Then submit.</p>
